## Adopt a Family

There are now **2 ways** to participate!

### **1. Monetary Donations:**

- Money donations are still welcome!
- 100% of donations will go to purchasing gift cards
- In addition to gifts, every family identified will receive money to a local grocery store and Target.

### **2. Adopt a Family**

When adopting a family, you commit to:

- Getting each child in the family 1 big or 2 small gifts
- Providing each child with new uniform clothes (if requested)
- Providing each child with warm jackets and shoes (if requested)
- Providing single moms or dads with a gift
- Providing the family with other home needs (blankets, pots/pans, furniture, electronics, etc.)

All gifts get wrapped and clearly labeled **prior** to drop off.

It is fun to work with friends. **Join** with 1 or a few families to adopt a family in need.

WGE families in need will be **anonymous.**

## Frequently Asked Questions

### 1. Can I adopt a family by myself?

You can, but it is fun to work with friends and divide up responsibilities. Be creative, join with extended family or other families in one or more classes.

### 2. Can I adopt a single child within a family?

No. Families are adopted as a whole.

### 3. How will I know how many children a family has and what their needs are?

Just ask. We have families with 1-4 children and many different needs depending circumstances.

### 4. What is the financial commitment to adopting a family?

This varies with family and what children put on their wishlist. But you can think of it like you are gifting to close friends, as well as providing for other needs (warm clothes, home needs, etc).

### 5. Do I need to get everything on a child's wishlist?

No. Each child will get 2 small gifts (art supplies, books, small toys, etc) or 1 large gift (bike, skateboard, electronic, etc).

### 6. Will I know who the family is?

No. All family information remains confidential.

### 7. Can I donate money to go to the families as in years past?

Yes! You can donate directly on the PTA website. All donations will go towards purchasing each family with a gift card to the grocery store they frequent and an additional Target card for anything else they might need.

### 8. How do I prepare gifts for drop off?

All gifts need to be gift wrapped and labeled with family # and child #. Uniform clothes, warm jackets, and other needs do not need to be wrapped (simply labeled).

### 9. When and where do I drop off the gifts?

Sunday, December 12th between 12-2pm at Willow Glen Bible Church. There will be signs in the parking lot leading you to the drop off area.

### 10. What if I cannot make the drop off date?

Call or text Katie Settle (650.722.8812) to arrange an alternate date. All gifts need to arrive by Monday, December 13th (end of day).
